“Question papers for all Examinations shall be set and answered in the Urdu Language subject to the condition that question papers for all examinations in the languages shall be set and answered in the respective languages.”

In the light of above Ordinance, and Statutory provisions, it is hereby reiterated that all the question papers shall be in Urdu and the students shall write the answer in Urdu, except for languages like Arabic, English, Hindi and Persian. If a student fails to write answers in Urdu, no marks shall be awarded to him/her.

From the Vice Chancellor's Desk

**The Idea of a University for 21st Century
Maulana Azad National Urdu University**

Looking at the present trend of the exigencies in several educational processes, at college and university levels, where the stress is primarily given on the applied aspects of knowledge, many scholars and educationists are pondering over the possibilities of alternative approaches to education, particularly at the tertiary level. Some of them are reflecting over the possibilities of holistic education.

There is a need to widen the vision of our perceptions. Against this theoretical background the MANUU should formulate its programme of Interdisciplinary Studies and Integrated Research, which envisages to organize, commission and participate across the disciplines in Urdu language and literature, comparative literature, social sciences, philosophy, comparative religions, linguistics, modern sciences and culture studies encompassing the social sciences and the humanities with the deepest concern for the relations between the scientific, cultural, corporate and political communities. This would be commensurate with the new realities of the 21st century.

An important and necessary function of MANUU, at this challenging moment in the changing world order, will be to become a centre which can help interpret Indian knowledge systems with intercultural exchange with other Western cultures, and for greater understanding of India's needs, pre-suppositions and aspirations. It will associate eminent scholars from within India and abroad with the execution of the collaborative research projects. While doing this we are assuming a proactive role of engaging in various educational, research and training activities in the service of society.

We thus envision the MANUU as a hub of scholarship and an agent of cross-cultural studies. We envision it to;

- a) promote collaborative interdisciplinary research projects,
- b) initiate cross-cultural dialogues through seminars and workshops, and joint research programmes,
- c) arrange to have scholars-in-residence for varying periods of time from various institutes/nations,
- d) deliberate on the implications of new technologies, economic and trade and management policies,
- e) promote courses in the language and literature of many nations, particularly of the European as well as Asian continent,
- f) provide ambiance and facilities for social and scholastic meeting with informed citizenry at large, and
- g) to take up contemporary concerns of institution building and practice and voluntary action. In sum, we envision the MANUU to be an independent scholastic centre of advanced studies in Urdu medium of instruction.

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1. University Profile

Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) is a Central University, established by an Act of Parliament in 1998 with all India jurisdiction. The headquarters and main campus of MANUU is in Gachibowli, Hyderabad. It is spread over 200 acres. MANUU is recognized as a major higher education service provider across the remote areas of the country in Urdu Medium through its regular and distance mode programmes. MANUU commenced with distance education programmes in 1998 and consolidated its regular academic and research programmes in 2004.

The University is named after Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, a scholar par excellence, a prolific writer, an inimitable orator, a gallant freedom fighter, a visionary of the post independent Indian education system and an architect of technical and scientific education in Independent India.

Presently, MANUU is in the process of consolidating the existing institutions, while expanding it to reach the unreached through various intervention measures. Further, to meet the rising aspirations of its youth in general and Urdu speaking community in specific, the University is making considerable progress in all fronts of academics, research and governance with specific vision, mission and objectives.

There are seven Schools of studies which offer academic programs through 19 Departments and 6 Section. The Departments are currently offering 95 programmes (27 Ph.D.; 28 PG; 10 UG, 09 Diploma and 21 PG Diploma programmes and Certificate courses)

1.1 School of Education and Training

MANUU has focused on preparing teachers for Urdu medium schools since its inception. The first batch of D.Ed. Programme was started in 2001 followed by the establishment of the Department of Education and Training in 2004 with the addition of B.Ed. Programme in the same year.

The School of Education & Training was established in 2006. The objective of School of Education and Training is to prepare a community of excellent school teachers and teacher educators rooted in tradition and well equipped for future. The emphasis of the school is on the functional relationship between knowledge generation, theory development and effective practice through Urdu medium. The School of Education & Training is well equipped in terms of faculty and infrastructure.

1.1.1 Department of Education and Training

The School has a Department of Education and Training at the University Campus at Hyderabad that imparts quality education in modern pattern through Urdu medium at different levels of teacher education from Diploma (D.El.Ed), Under Graduate (B.Ed.), Post-Graduate (M.Ed.) to Research level (Ph.D.) programmes. The research focus is on Teacher Education, Minority Education, Madrasa Education, Distance Education, Inclusive Education, Environmental Education, ICT in Education and Comparative Education.

1.1.2 Constituent Colleges of Teacher Education

The School has a network of eight constituent Colleges of Teacher Education spread across the country. The School through its eight constituent Colleges of Teacher Education offers B.Ed. Programme located at Srinagar (J&K), Darbhanga (Bihar), Bhopal (MP), Sambhal (UP), Asansol (WB), Aurangabad (MS), Bidar (Karnataka) and Nuh (Haryana). Further, M.Ed. and Ph.D. programmes are also offered at two Colleges of Teacher Education located at Darbhanga (Bihar) and Bhopal (MP).

1.1.3 Integrated Teacher Education Programme

The 4-year integrated B.Ed. will be a dual-major holistic bachelor's degree, in Education as well as a specialized subject (such as language, history, music, mathematics, computer science, chemistry, economics, art, physical-education, etc). Beyond the teaching of cutting-edge pedagogy, the teacher education will include a grounding in sociology, history, science, psychology, early childhood care,

and education, foundational literacy and numeracy, knowledge of India and its values/ethos/art/traditions, and more. [NEP 2020: 15.5]

The ITEP is a Dual Major Programme -the first major is in Education with School Specific Stage specialization and the second major is in an opted discipline. The approach to the design and implementation of ITEP are:

- Education in Multidisciplinary Environment
- 4 Year duration after grade 12 of the school system
- Admission through National Common Entrance Test (NCET) conducted by NTA
- Minimal degree qualification to become a teacher by 2030
- Responsive to new 5+3+3+4 design
- Introduction of Credit System as per UGC
- Integrated Dual-Major Degree- Disciplinary & Professional Knowledge of Education
- Focus on 21st Century Skills
- Stage Specialization (5+3+3+4): Each student will specialize in one of the following school stages which will qualify them to become teachers of that Stage:
 - i. Foundational Stage Specialization (for teaching Pre-School to Grade 2)
 - ii. Preparatory Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 3 to Grade 5)
 - iii. Middle Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 6 to Grade 8)
 - iv. Secondary Stage Specialization (for teaching Grades 9 to Grade 12)

The Department of Education and Training, MANUU Hyderabad campus is one of the institutions granted permission by NCTE to run the ITEP programme(secondary) under Humanities, Commerce and Sciences i.e., 4 years integrated B.A. B.Ed., 4 years integrated B.Com. B.Ed.and 4 years integrated B.Sc. B.Ed.

2.0 Criteria for Admissions

2.1 General Eligibility Conditions

- i. The candidates are required to compulsorily go through the NTA information bulletin and MANUU ITEP Prospectus before filling up their online application forms for their admission.
- ii. For admission in University programmes,
- iii. Urdu as a subject/language or as a Medium in 10th/12th/Graduation level or equivalent Madrasa courses with Urdu as medium of Instruction approved by MANUU. **(For Proof of Urdu)**
- iv. Candidates with minimum fifty percent marks in Senior Secondary or plus two (+2) examination or its equivalent (under 5+3+3+4 pattern) from a recognized board are eligible for admission.
- v. Relaxation as per GOI norms.
- vi. Candidates studied from State Madrasa Education board are also eligible to apply for the ITEP programme.

2.2 Age limit for Admissions

Following is the table of prescribed age limit for various programmes of the University:

2.3 Details of National Common Entrance Test (NCET)

The National Testing Agency has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) and inviting Online Applications of the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) for admission to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) in selected Central/State University/Institutions including IITs, NITs, RIEs, and Government Colleges for the Academic Session 2023-24.

Admission Procedure for MANUU:

1. Admission in ITEP shall be through the score obtained in National Common entrance Test (NCET) conducted by NTA.
2. At the time of application to the programme, the candidate must indicate the subjects/discipline (B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed./B.Com. B.Ed.)
3. Candidates who wish to join ITEP in MANUU **should select Urdu as a compulsory subject as Language 1 in Section -1**
4. In Section -2 , candidates should select three domain specific subjects from the following combinations:
 - a) B.A.B.Ed - Political Science/ History/ Geography/ Economics (Any three)
 - b) B.Sc.B.Ed - Mathematics/ Physics/ Chemistry/ Biology (Any three)
 - c) B.Com. B.Ed - Accountancy/ Business Studies/ Business Economics/ Entrepreneurship (Any three)

3.0 Reservation and Relaxation Provisions

The University follows the reservation policies of the Government of India issued from time to time. The reservations are applicable to all programmes. There are two kinds of reservations (Vertical and Horizontal) adopted by the University to accommodate adequate representation of various categories of students as an inclusive policy. The applicants claiming any of these categories need to submit the valid proof of the caste/ tribe/ other reservation in the prescribed form issued by the competent authorities as per the Government of India norms at the time of admission, failing which applicant shall not be considered for admission.

3.1 Reservations for SCs/STs/OBCs /Women candidates/EWS Categories

The following table summarises the details of **quota** for SCs/STs/OBCs/Women Candidates and EWS Categories as per **Govt. of India and University norms in each programme:**

- Semester fee must be paid within two weeks of commencement of Semester and with prescribed late fee till the end of fourth week, failing which admission is liable to cancellation.
- Any re-admission has to be completed within 2 weeks of commencement of classes.
