HOSTEL RE-OPENING NOTICE-2023-24

(For Re-Admission boarders Only)

Dear Boarders of Boys & Girls Hostels,

This is to bring to your notice that in the wake of University's decision to re-open the classes for the academic year 2023-24 from 28th August, 2023, this Notice is being issued. **The Hostels will re-open for Re-Admission students** (i.e., Boarders of Boys & Girls Hostels who were already allotted the hostel facility during previous academic year).

The eligible Re-admission boarders of the Girls & Boys Hostels may join the Hostel facility from 26th August, 2023. The Boarders are hereby informed to **join the hostels in person before 11th September**, otherwise their seat will be cancelled and allotted to other eligible students. However, if any boarder could not report before 11th September, 2023 with any valid and genuine reason, the boarder will be allowed till 18th September, 2023, with the recommendation of the concerned HoD. No extension will be allowed for joining the hostels thereafter in any circumstances.

The **Mess facility** will commence from **05th September, 2023**, subject to joining of minimum of 100 students at the hostels.

The boarders of the Hostels shall download the '**Undertaking**' attached at **Annexure-A** and at the time of joining the University/Hostel facility, the eligible boarders shall bring the '**Undertaking**' **duly signed by his/her Parent/Guardian.**

The Application Form will be provided by hostel officials at the time of arrival and after completing the application formalities, the hostel/mess fees to be paid in person. **The Boarders are advised not to pay any hostel/mess fee before arrival.**

The students are advised to reach the University campus on working days during working hours, so that Health Checkup may be facilitated for obtaining "Fitness Certificate" from the University Health Centre to join the hostel facility.



The eligible boarders who are allowed to join the University Campus/Hostels facility/Departments, must adhere to the COVID Guidelines of the University, as well as any future guidelines issued by the Government of India/Ministry of Education/UGC/ Government of Telangana from time to time. The students are requested to cooperate with university authorities in implementing safety and health protocol and steps taken in case any emergencies arise due to **COVID-19 Pandemic or other health related concerns on the Campus/ surrounding areas.**
